# Kid Adventure Guide

## Museum of the Rockies

This renowned local museum is home to the Siebel Dinosaur Complex, one of the largest collections of dinosaur fossils in the world. If kids love anything, it's dinosaurs! In addition to Montana's Rex, one of the few mounted T-Rex skeletons in the United States, Museum of the Rockies offers additional permanent and changing exhibitions.

## Bozeman Hot Springs

Soothing year round, Bozeman Hot Springs offers numerous pools varying in temperature. Snacks and beverages are served and some nights live music is featured on the outside stage.

## Tubing the Madison River

Float the Madison River in a tube or on a SUP (Standup Paddle Board). Local shuttle companies can rent you all equipment including tubes, floatation devices, coolers, and stereos, and shuttle you to the put in and from the take out locations.

## Hike to Palisade Falls

This 1.2 mile hike is located in the beautiful Hyalite Recreation Area. Palisade Falls drops 80 feet off a vertical rock wall. The hike takes about 30 minutes round trip (longer with kids that like to look under every rock).

## Montana Science Center

Kids love the hands-on art and science exhibits, summer science camps, and educational programs. STEAMlab allows kids to build circuits, learn how to 3D print, learn how electronics work, and more.

## Spire Climbing + Fitness

Spire offers 12,000 square feet of roped climbing to heights up to 50 feet and 6,000 square feet of bouldering. Adults can take a yoga class while children climb with instructors.
