Cancellation Policy: We have a 48 hour cancellation policy for all single day safaris, 7 day policy for 2-day and 3-day safaris and a 30 day policy for all safaris that are 4 days or longer. Cancellations made before the cancellation policy goes into effect will receive a full refund. Cancellations made within the cancellation policy, but before the day of departure will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations or no-shows on the day of departure will not be refunded. SUMMER SAFARIS - (MAY-OCTOBER)

Yellowstone Wildlife Safari - Full Day

Travel through the Northern Range of Yellowstone National Park while watching for wildlife and stopping frequently for photo-ops. Highlights include geologic features, free ranging herds of bison and elk, pronghorn, bears and even a chance to see wolves.

Best of Yellowstone Safari - Full Day

Experience Yellowstone National Park by vehicle for an entire day with our private and personalized full day safari tour. Explore popular and lesser known attractions in Yellowstone including hydrothermal features, incredible canyons, waterfalls while watching for wildlife. We will tour the Lower Loop whichs includes Old Faithful, Yellowstone Lake, Hayden Valley with its iconic wildlife and the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone (if time allows).

2 Day Bear and Wolf Safari - Multi Day

This two day safari will focus on tracking and observing bears and wolves in the Northern Range or Yellowstone with time to also explore some of the park's ocinic features. Learn about these fascinating animals and observe them in their natural habitat. Your professional naturalist guide will interpret the many facets in the lives of these animals and help you to understand the events taking place on the landscape before you.

3 Day Bear and Wolf Safari - Multi Day

This three day safari tour heads into the park with the goal of seeing black bears, grizzly bears, gray wolves and other wildlife. There will also be plenty of time to explore the iconic Yellowstone places along the way including Old Faithful, Canyon, Yellowstone Lake and a variety of geyser basins. Your professional naturalist guide will interpret the animal behavior and help you understand the meaning behind their actions.

WINTER SAFARIS - (NOVEMBER-APRIL)

Yellowstone Wildlife Safari - Full Day

View some of Yellowstone's greatest animals on a big wintry landscape. The Northern Range of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem harbors the greatest diversity and concentration of large, iconic and highly visible wildlife anywhere during a North American winter. Experience the chance to see hundreds to thousands of bison and elk, packs of coyotes and wolves, herds of bighorn, mule deer, pronghorn and eagles flying.

Yellowstone Snowshoe Safari - Full Day

Snowshoe through Yellowstone National Park and surrounding wild lands to experience the wilds of winter away from the road. Experience the solitude of winter in Yellowstone while learning about winter ecology, snow science and wildlife tracking.

2 and 3 Day Winter Wolves and Wildlife Safari - Multi Day

Winter is the best season for wolf watching in Yellowstone National Park. Elk are concentrated at lower elevations in large herds. The snowy backdrop provides a good background where wolves are easily seen as they track, hunt, or feed in the open landscape. Choose between our 2 and 3 day options to spend time tracking and watching wolves with spotting scopes and binoculars. All lodging, meals and an expert guide will make this all-inclusive itinerary a trip of a lifetime.
